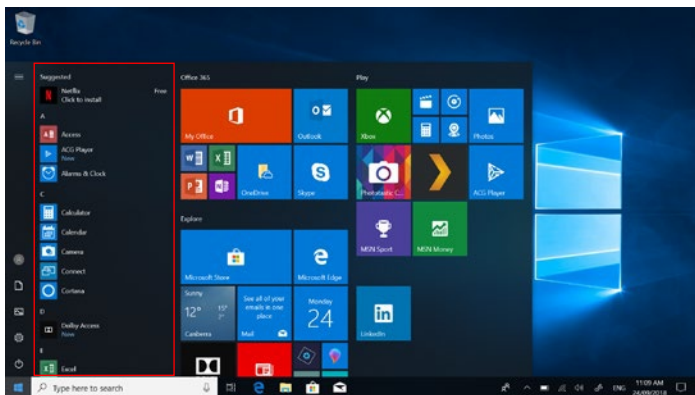
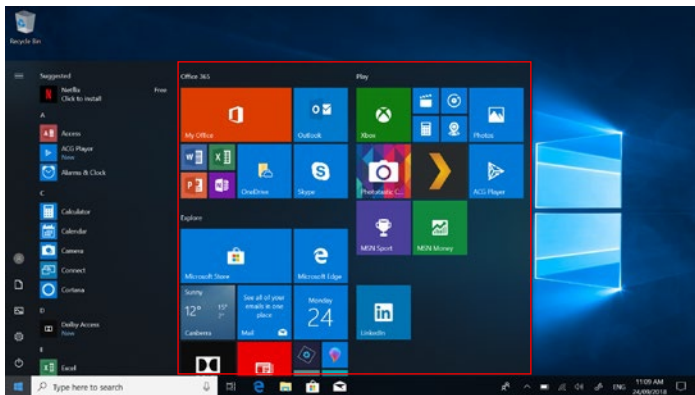
1. Windows 10 Start Screen

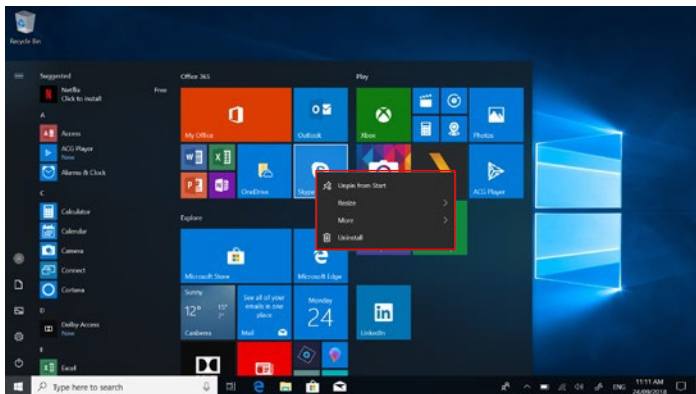


2. Apps Introduction

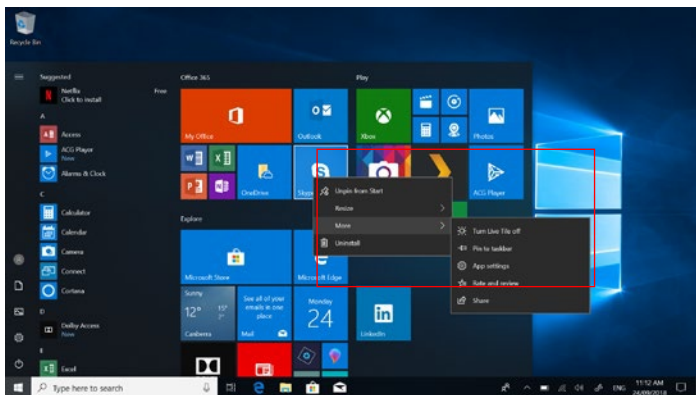
Besides the pinned applications (tiles) you can also start any application installed on the unit from the menu on the left, by scrolling down through the list to find your selected application.

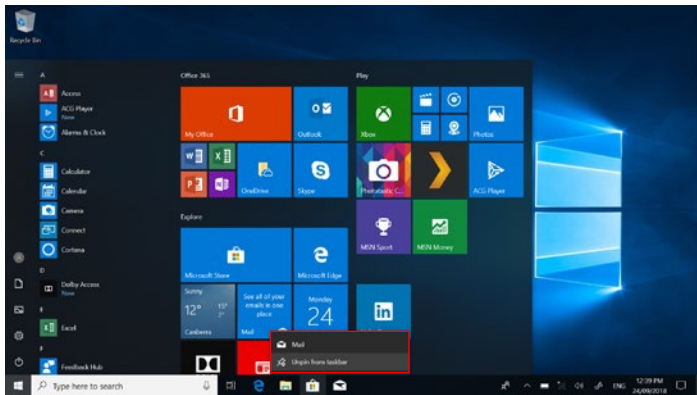


If you want to pin more applications to the Start Screen or taskbar, you can right click the application and click Pin To Start or under the More menu, Pin To Taskbar.



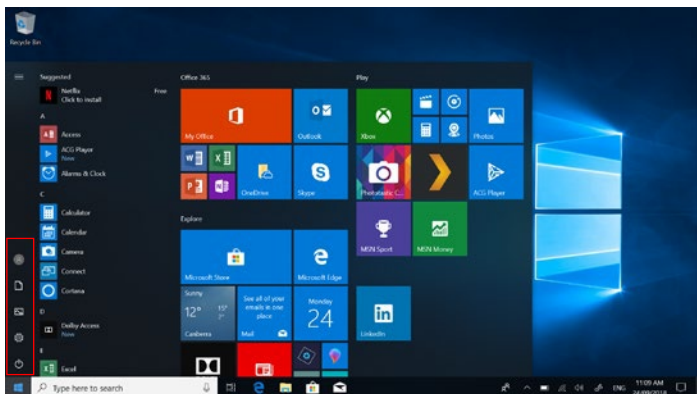
If you want to cancel or delete a certain application in the start screen or taskbar, right click the application, click Unpin From Start or Unpin this program from taskbar.



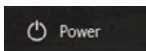

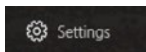
The Start Menu also has icons on the left hand side for access to documents and settings.

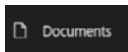

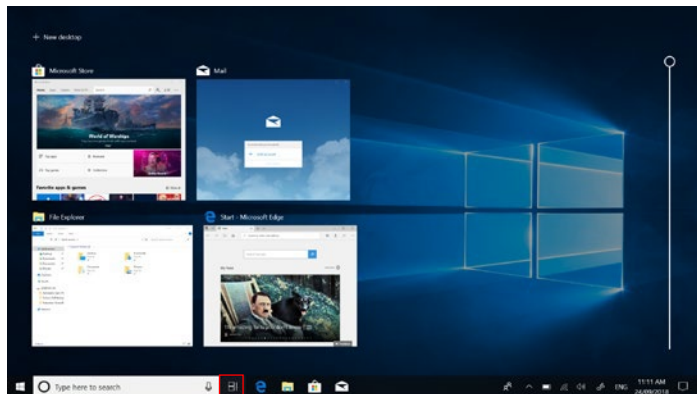
4. Action Center



Action Center is a notification and quick access notification center. It allows for changes to regularly used settings like Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, Screen Brightness and more.

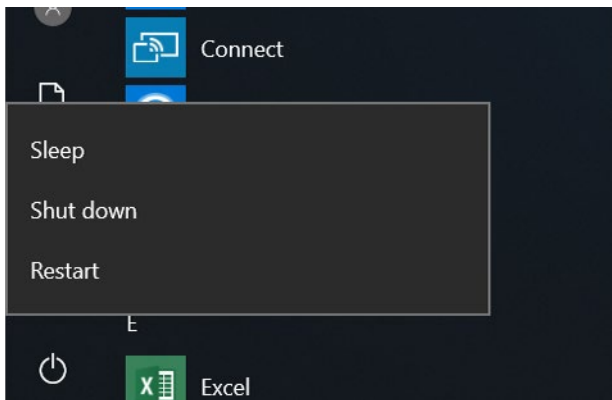
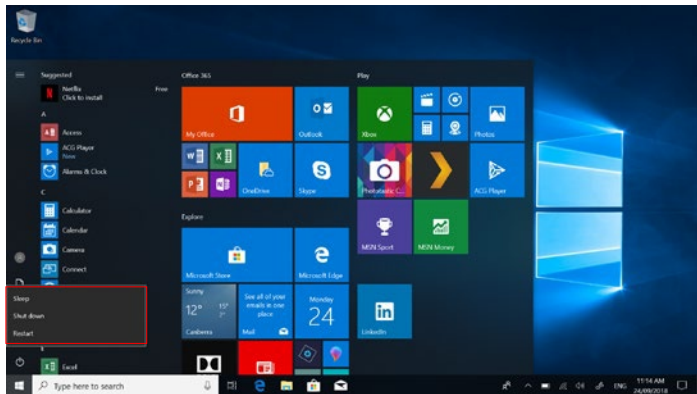
5. Task View
